On the other hand, in the translation profession, special attention is paid to the study of administrative English (through a series of practical activities within subjects related to the language of profession - the language of law, economics and the EU institution, oral translation and interpretation), which, above all when it comes to paying attention to personal development, is necessary for the adequate implementation of the current Euro-Atlantic integration process of Montenegro.
