UDG strategy - education model represented through the "Professor's equation"



This model is known as "Professor's Equation" and it is the innovative approach to the organization of studies and teaching at UDG.

Using this model, we aim to "produce" individuals who are **<u>uncertainty experts</u>**, capable of making the right decisions even with insufficient information, seeing far beyond the superficial. In our complex and ever-changing world, the probability of having all the information is very close to zero. The fact is that there is no "safe zone" nowadays.

This approach is based on decades of experience, as well as how my students have embraced the approach, and their following success. I've invested years in analyzing study programs and teaching in general, taking "creative destruction" (J. Schumpeter), "uncertainty principle" (W. Heisenberg), and "creative evolution" (H. Bergson) into account. This has unequivocally led me to a statement by Njegos -"Whatever comes, I am ready". This represents how I perceive uncetainty experts and it is the guiding idea by which studies are organized at UDG.

The Food Quality & Safety Laboratory

The Food Quality & Safety Laboratory - established by pooling funds from the HERIC project, Ministry of Agriculture and UDG. The two basic objectives of the laboratory are:

- organization of laboratory exercises for undergraduate and postgraduate students
- analysis of food samples for market needs as well as for research activities

Within the laboratory, it is possible to carry out chemistry, microbiology and molecular biology analyses. The aim is to implement ISO standards in the domain of analytical methods that would further serve for students' training, commercial affairs, and research.

Established in 2016 aiming to provide students of the Faculty of Information Technology and students of the MSc program - Cyber Security, with additional theoretical knowledge in the field of computer networks as well as practical experience in working with real network devices in the assigned network laboratories.

IDEALAND - Business ideas exchange market

This is an event where students present their business ideas ("Ideas supply"). These ideas are the "supply". Idea representatives - creators of 11 chosen ideas - have three minutes to present their idea. Various organizations, companies, banks, institutions and individuals, both from Montenegro and abroad, participate in this exercise, commenting and expressing interest.

European Masters in Official Statistics (EMOS)

Master studies at the Faculty of International Economics. Finance and Business started according to a standardized program accredited by Eurostat - European Statistical System.

Entrepreneurial Economy

The first volume of economic journal "Entrepreneurial Economy – was first published in 2002.



Over the previous nine years, over 800 business ideas, thought up by both university & high school students, as well as other young people from all over the world, have been submitted.



Culture and Tourism

China studies

Focused on researching modern China in a global, as well as historic context. The program is based on research of culture, history, philosophy, and economics of the country, which is the leading world economy. As China's global influence is predicted to rise in the following years, especially through the Belt and Road Initiative. Montenegro has already started international cooperation with China. The number of Montenegrin young people who want to visit China is rising. The number of Chinese tourists in Montenegro is increasing too. Chinese investors are opening their companies in Montenegro. Montenegrins are also starting businesses in China. This trend will only accelerate in the coming years.



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UDG Conferences

On average, **10 international conferences are organized annually at UDG**. UDG representatives actively participate at conferences, international events, and as part of international delegations.

UDG co-organizes the **Regional Milocer Development Forum – a major Southeastern Europe development conference.** The Forum does not produce recipes and explanations for current issues, but rather stimulates thoughts and new ideas, awakening every individual's awareness regarding their obligation to self-develop and improve their local environment.
