## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

First Enrollment Period for Admission to the First Year of Undergraduate Studies for the Academic Year 2026/2027

Documents for enrollment in the first year of studies may be submitted in two ways: **in person at the UDG building or electronically.**

Candidates applying electronically must create a user account at: <https://upis.udg.edu.me/>

Through this account they will be identified, and their secondary school grades will be automatically retrieved from the MEIS system.

Candidates who have not completed their education within the Montenegrin educational system and whose grades are therefore not available in MEIS may complete the enrollment process by uploading scanned copies of all required documents listed in this Call for Applications to the same platform (the system will automatically redirect them to the appropriate form).

All admitted candidates are required to submit original documents. Instructions regarding the submission of original documents will be sent to the candidate's e-mail address.

## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL FACULTIES

1. Holders of the **Luča I** and **Luča II** awards are exempt from tuition fees. Tuition fees for the second child from the same family enrolling at UDG are reduced by **20%**. The third and each subsequent child from the same family are exempt from tuition fees.<sup>1</sup>
2. Tuition fees amount to **€2,200** per year (two semesters). Tuition fees will not increase until the completion of undergraduate studies. Tuition fees for the International Hospitality and Management and Applied Psychology study programmes amount to **€2,800** per year.
3. Tuition may be financed through a special student loan provided by Hipotekarna Banka (**payable in 12 monthly installments**).

<sup>1</sup> The tuition reduction for the second child, and exemption for each subsequent child, applies provided that the first or second child is an active student who has settled all financial obligations for the current academic year, has already graduated, or has paid full tuition for three academic years.

4. Tuition may also be paid in three installments, in which case the annual tuition fee amounts to **€2,300**, payable by September 1st, December 1st, and April 1st. For students enrolled in International Hospitality and Management and Applied Psychology, tuition amounts to **€2,900** when paid in installments. Information on installment amounts will be provided after enrollment.

5. Students may simultaneously obtain a major and a minor diploma. The major diploma is awarded by the home faculty, while the minor diploma is awarded by the faculty where the student completes the courses prescribed for the minor qualification in that scientific field. In the forthcoming academic year, the following combinations are available:

- FMEFB – FPN
- FMEFB – FIST

6. In accordance with the Higher Education Act, students of all public and private higher education institutions enjoy equal rights regarding **student accommodation and meals, student loans, scholarships for top-performing students, and healthcare.**

7. Entrepreneurship, Management and Business (PMB) and the Faculty of Sports Management (FSM) are applied study programmes.

### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND SCORING CRITERIA FOR ALL FACULTIES**

1. All candidates who have completed a four-year secondary school programme in Montenegro or abroad are eligible to apply (all types of schools are considered appropriate).
2. Domestic and international students have equal rights and obligations and pay the same tuition fees.
3. Candidates are required to submit original copies of all necessary documents.
4. Candidates may apply simultaneously to two UDG faculties.
5. Scoring criteria include:
  - Overall academic performance (all four years of secondary education);
  - Results achieved on the external secondary school leaving examination or vocational examination;
  - Performance in relevant secondary school subjects;
  - Luča I and Luča II awards;
  - Achievements in academic and artistic competitions;
  - Sporting achievements.

### **ORGANIZATION AND DEADLINES**

Enrollment documents may be submitted electronically or in person at the UDG building on: 25th, 26th and 29th of June, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR ENROLLMENT**

1. Completed scoring form (for candidates submitting documents in person at the University);
2. Secondary school transcripts for all completed grades;
3. Diploma/certificate of passing the external secondary school leaving examination or vocational examination;
4. Luča diploma or equivalent award certificate;
5. Copy of a biometric identity card; foreign nationals must provide an appropriate identification document issued in accordance with applicable regulations;
6. Photograph (passport-dimensions; candidates applying in person must provide two photographs).
