Member Recommendation Guideline

The ANSO Scholarship for Young Talents (hereinafter refer to as *the ANSO Scholarship*) is one of ANSO's major approaches to promote regional and global capacity building.

200 master's and 300 PhD candidates will be sponsored by the ANSO Scholarship to study in the University of Science and Technology of China (USTC), the University of Chinese Academy of Sciences (UCAS) and institutes of CAS around China.

ANSO Member Recommendation

We welcome ANSO members to recommend competitive candidates to apply for the ANSO Scholarship. In general, each ANSO member can recommend *up to 4 candidates* (Master's and PhDs in total).

ANSO member fills out the Recommendation Form (Attachment 1), gets it signed by the legal representative and sends it back to the ANSO Secretariat. The deadline of submission is 1st February 2023.

Under similar circumstances, ANSO Member-recommended applicants will be given priority in the review.



Note

- 1) Make sure that the recommended students meet with the eligibility.
- 2) The recommended students **MUST** complete the application procedure as [the 2023 Call for Applications](#) required. If he/she failed to do so, USTC/UCAS could not proceed to review his/her materials.
