


## To: Whom it may concern

## **BEUM 2013 topics**

Apart from providing our participants with valuable knowledge and skills, we tend to introduce them with very current and interesting topics that will be discussed on the simulation. This year, the participants that will be simulating the work of the European Council on BEUM 2013 will be discussing **anti** - **corruption measures on the Western Balkans**, while the participants in the European Parliament and the Council of the EU will amend two legislative proposals: **Directive on the deployment of alternative fuels infrastructure** and **Regulation establishing a financial instrument for the promotion of the democracy and human rights worldwide**.

**BEUM 2013** offers a valuable educational experience, by being an efficient tool for learning more about the decission making procedures within the EU. Students are given the opportunity to experience theory in practice, which will enable them to better understand the political cooperation as well as the composition of the EU bodies.

We would be very grateful if you could inform the students of your University about Belgrade Model European Union 2013 and the opportunities it provides. We are looking forward to meeting them in Belgrade in October. The application dates are set between 1<sup>st</sup> of August and 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2013.
