

University of Donja Gorica and Spiru Haret University, Bucharest, Romania signed a cooperation agreement

University of Donja Gorica hosted Prof. Manuela Epure, PhD, MCIM Vice Rector of Research & International Relations at Spiru Haret University who gave a lecture on 21st & 22nd March on the topic - Research methods in the social sciences.

During her lecture, Prof. Manuela Epure presented the quantitative and qualitative research methods, the ways of networking and the available research tools.

Cooperation agreement between University of Donja Gorica and Spiru Haret University, Bucharest, Romania was signed on March 22nd in the Rector's Office at the University of Donja Gorica.
